In 1997, an amendment of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) included the language, “**Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports**,” which described methods used to identify and support desired behaviors in the school setting. The educational research community has been developing and studying Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) ever since. 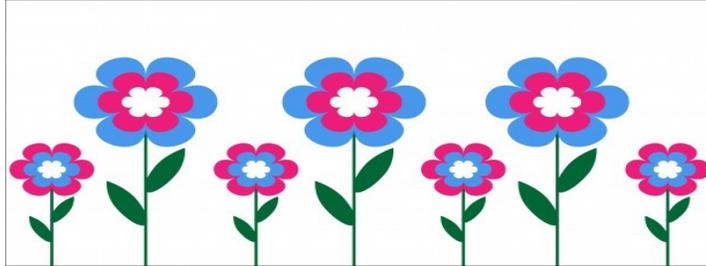
