### PARKING LOT SAFETY

As a review, please remember that we all must work together to ensure the safety of our families as we move in and out of the school parking lot. Here are a few reminders of the safety rules for our parking lot and bus loop.

- 1. Do not park in a handicapped spot if you do not have a handicap placard.
